Bishop-Elect Paul Martin's Ordination transport update:

There will be no parking available in the grounds of Christchurch Boys' High School. The best options are taxi/bus/drop off. There will be a drop off area for the elderly or disabled.

Some parishes may be organising buses themselves, and the Diocese is making available a 'park and ride' options at three venues in the city. Spaces are limited. There will be buses travelling to the venue, leaving at 9.30am from:

St Teresa's, Puriri Street, Riccarton.

Holy Trinity, 108 Jeffreys Rd, Bryndwr.

St Mary's Pro-Cathedral, 373 Manchester St.

The 'park and ride' buses will depart from Christchurch Boys' High at 2.30pm. If you miss the return bus you will need to make your own return arrangements. To book a seat on one of these buses, please let your parish secretary know by Wednesday 21st February.
