**Bishop's Proposed Plan**

Following Bishop Paul's announcement last weekend, the information on the Bishop's proposed plan can be found on the website [www.ourfaith.chchcatholic.nz](http://www.ourfaith.chchcatholic.nz)

In the bishop's announcement he invites us to reflect and pray about his proposal for another week before the feedback process opens on 22<sup>nd</sup> June. For ease of collation feedback online is encouraged although there will be hard copies of the evaluation form available if needed. The feedback questionnaire comprises specific questions as well as space for people to give general feedback. The feedback process allows for individual or group feedback.

**PRISON CHAPLAIN VACANCY**

A vacancy exists in the Catholic chaplaincy team for a full time position (40 hours per week), working in both Rolleston Prison and Christchurch Men's Prison.

The role requires a special combination of experience, skill, formation and personal qualities. Applicants will come from a committed Catholic ministry background, should demonstrate a personal faith commitment, relevant pastoral formation and experience, a high level of personal maturity and judgement, a resilient personality and success in working in teams.

The chaplain is part of the Catholic and ecumenical chaplaincy teams and will provide for the celebration of the sacraments, lead prayer services, provide pastoral care and support for prisoners.
